Launched by Greenview in 2016, the Hotel Owners for Tomorrow (HOT) Coalition emerged as an industry-leading coalition of over thirty-five participating organizations united by a common goal — to get hotel owners in Asia engaged in sustainability discussions and actions.

There was no cost to join. Instead, members committed to five simple actions:

- 1. Incorporate sustainability from the beginning of investment decisions
- 2. Evaluate one renewable energy project efficiency project per year
- 3. Routinely monitor and benchmark sustainability
- 4. Support brand efforts
- 5. Share best practices

While much work remains to be done, the initial goal to generate awareness and convene discussions for hotel owners across the region has largely been set in motion.
